Delivered using the innovative **Team Academy methodology**, learners gain real-world experience through hands-on projects and challenges.

Programme Overview

The Futuremakers programme is designed to blend classroom learning with practical application. Over 2.5 days, participants engage in dynamic, hands-on classroom sessions to build their skills in enterprise, teamwork, creativity, problem-solving, and self-improvement. This is followed by 2.5 days dedicated to a **live business challenge** provided by a local business or organisation. Participants work collaboratively to apply their learning in real-time, tackling the challenge and developing innovative solutions. This approach transforms theoretical knowledge into actionable outcomes, giving learners invaluable experience in addressing real-world business and community needs.

Programme Features

- **Practical, Experiential Learning:** Students apply their knowledge directly to real-world community and business challenges, fostering deeper understanding and retention.

Business Challenge

Delivery: Day 4 Full day

Working with a TASC Team coach participants begin to break down the business challenge and explore solutions to address the client's challenge.

Business Challenge Results Presentation

Delivery: Day 5 Morning

The team deliver their solution presentation to the client and obtain feedback on their solutions. **Skills Developed**: Collaboration, problem-solving, creativity, project management, adaptability, and real-world application of learning.

How to Keep Improving

Delivery: Day 5 Afternoon

Students reflect on their learning and development needs, recognising how personal improvement connects to business success and prepares them for future opportunities.

Skills Developed: Self-assessment, growth mindset, career readiness.
