Delivery: A day long bootcamp for the whole school broken down into hour long sessions per year group and followed by a 30-minute staff briefing session.

Objective: Spark creativity and teach pupils how to find inspiration in everyday life. Familiarise pupils with the programme and reduce nerves through an engaging introduction that outlines the programme's themes and selection process.

Session 2: Applications and selection.

Facilitator: Teacher & TASC.Delivery: 1 hour virtual meeting.Objective: Working together to select the successful applicants for the programme.

Session 3: Developing Your Ideas Facilitator: Teacher. Delivery: 1 hour lesson. Objective: Transform initial ideas into story concepts using the "See, Think, Wonder" framework.

Session 4: Storytelling Basics Facilitator: TASC. Delivery: 1 hour workshop.

Objective: Teach the fundamentals of storytelling and connecting with an audience.

Session 5: Using Facts & Data

Facilitator: Teacher. Delivery: 1 hour lesson. Objective: Introduce research and factual presentation techniques. Session 6: Developing Your Script Facilitator: TASC. Delivery: 1 hour workshop. Objective: Refine storytelling and build confidence through structured feedback.

Session 7: Know Your Audience Facilitator: Teacher. Delivery: 1 hour lesson. Objective: Teach clarity and adaptability to audience needs.

Session 8: Communicate with Power

Facilitator: TASC.Delivery: 1 hour workshop.Objective: Master vocal techniques and body language for impactful delivery.

Session 9: Remembering Your Talk Facilitator: Teacher. Delivery: 1 hour lesson. Objective: Help pupils rehearse and internalise their presentations using memory techniques.

Session 10: Own the Room/Take the Stage Finale Event Facilitator: TASC. Delivery: Full day delivered as half day workshop and half day celebration event. Objective: Morning - Build stage presence and overcome stage fright through practice. Afternoon - Participants deliver their talks to a live audience.
